Poncho "Giuliana"

This pattern belongs to _____



This poncho is very very easy!

Skill level: Beginner

Finished measurements: one size for adults

Yarn: 450 gr wool that go with the needle size

Other materials: tapestry needle

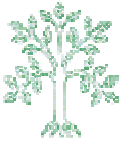
scissors

a hook if you want to make a lace around the neck

Needle size: US – 10.5 / 6.5 mm.

Gauge: is not important in this project

Stitches - knit: **CO** (cast on), **BO** (bind off), **k** (knit), **p** (purl)



Poncho - make two pieces

C060

Row 1: k

Row 2: k

Row 3: k

Row 4: p

Rep rows 1 - 4 60 times

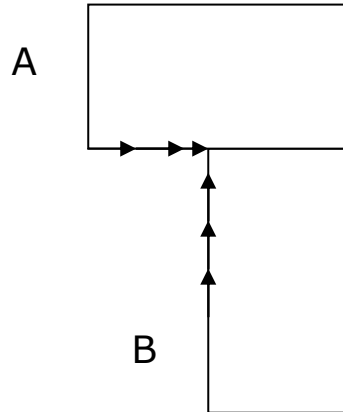
BO

Finishing 1

add the 2 pieces as drawing

Measure where to join site A to site B

Start to pick up the sts for the collar
(where you see the arrows)



Collar: from the right site pick about 120 sts (every other row)

Row 1 – 25: *k2, p2*, rep *-* across

BO

Finishing 1

Now join site A to site B, including the collar

Make a long crochet string and weave in where you picked up the sts.
